19:1–10 Zacchaeus gives away his riches

John 4:5–42 The Samaritan woman at the well
8:3–11 Jesus stops the stoning of a woman
10:10 That you may have life to the full
20:11–18 Jesus chooses a woman to announce the news of the Resurrection
